## THE STRATEGIC CLINICAL SERVICE PLAN 2012–22

### ANGLISS HOSPITAL

Angliss Hospital will support low to medium complexity inpatient and outpatient healthcare needs across an expanded range of general and specialty clinical services. These include emergency medicine, general medicine, general surgery, orthopaedic surgery, urology, maternity, cardiology, gastroenterology, renal dialysis, geriatric evaluation and management, and rehabilitation as well as programs to care for patients in their own homes.

The hospital will include critical care services that support the expanded range of clinical services required at the site and a busy emergency service.

As the new services are established, Angliss Hospital will be positioned to accommodate more complex patients.

Inpatient accommodation is a priority and the site will undergo revised master planning to ensure its buildings and infrastructure are able to meet future demands.

*Eastern Health 2022* recommends the following changes at Angliss Hospital:

- ▶ Introducing new orthopaedic surgical services
- ▶ Enhancing services for critically ill patients
- ▶ Increasing general surgery
- ▶ Increasing general medicine
- ▶ Increasing emergency services
- ▶ Maintaining emergency paediatric care and moving bed-based inpatient paediatric medicine and surgery
- ▶ Moving bed-based inpatient ear, nose and throat surgical services
- ▶ Increasing cardiology services
- ▶ Increasing gastroenterology services
- ▶ Increasing endoscopy services
- ▶ Establishing an Eastern Health centre for bed-based inpatient pain management
- ▶ Increasing urology services
- ▶ Increasing bed-based inpatient geriatric evaluation and management services
- ▶ Working in partnership with others to improve public transport and car parking at the site
- ▶ Exploring the acquisition of a magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) machine and infrastructure
