About Us

The Allied Health Clinical Research Office (AHCRO) at Eastern Health was established as a joint initiative between Eastern Health and La Trobe University, as part of the La Trobe University Academic and Research Collaborative in Health (ARCH). Led by Professor Nicholas Taylor and Professor Katherine Harding, the Allied Health Clinical Research Office promotes, supports and conducts clinical research. The activities of AHCRO are guided by the Allied Health Research Committee, which has representatives from programs, allied health disciplines and research active clinicians.

This year saw the expansion of the partnership between Eastern Health and La Trobe University through the establishment of a second professorial role. Katherine Harding was appointed to the jointly funded position of Professor of Allied Health (Implementation Science) enhancing ongoing opportunities for the research office to lead high quality research and support the building of research capacity for allied health staff at Eastern Health. In other changes to the AHCRO team, Dr Annie Lewis was appointed to the part time role of AHCRO manager, and Dr Fleur Terrens joined Annie to job share the Eastern Health's Research and Translation Fellowship until the end of the current term in March 2025.

La Trobe University and Eastern Health are further strengthening relationships with the introduction of a new clinician researcher PhD scholarship scheme commencing in 2024. Jointly funded stipends will provide allied health professionals at Eastern Health with financial support to undertake PhD studies, providing career opportunities as well as driving high quality research within Eastern Health. Eastern Health is supporting applications for stipends to **Germaine Tan** (investigating optimal timing of rehabilitation for people with cancer) and **Mel Haley** (evaluating service wide approaches to falls prevention) which we expect to commence in 2024. Germaine was simultaneously successful in receiving a highly competitive NHMRC PhD scholarship to help support her studies.

We continued to work on some major projects this year. The MIHip randomised controlled trial led by **Nick Taylor** investigating the benefits of motivational interviewing to enhance recovery after hip fracture completed data collection, with 200 older people with hip fracture recruited to the trial. Data are currently being analysed with results expected to be published in the coming year. **Katherine Harding** and **Annie Lewis** continue to lead a program of work improving demand management for outpatient and community health services. This research was heavily featured in a new demand management toolkit for community health services published by the Victorian Department of Health in 2023, and our team subsequently received \$200,000 in funding to support an education and support program to enhance demand management in community health services across Victoria. **Dr Kellie Emmerson** has joined the team as a project manager for this work, and the group will also be joined by PhD student **Kate Noeske** in 2024 to undertake an evaluation of this work.

Dr Amy Dennett continues to be a rising star, leading an internationally recognised program of work in oncology rehabilitation in her capacity as a Victorian Cancer Agency early career research fellow. Over the past 12 months she has completed a trial of a behavioural intervention to improve physical activity for patients during inpatient cancer treatment, and completed recruitment for a trial of a telerehabilitation group intervention for cancer survivors.

The annual **Allied Health Research Forum** was held in October in a hybrid format for the first time with over 50 staff attending in person and over 70 participating online. Following an inspiring presentation from guest speaker **Professor Nora Shields** from La Trobe University on the "Role of health professionals in promoting physical activity among people with disability", the 3-minute project competition gave our clinician researchers the opportunity to share their work in an interesting and entertaining afternoon. The prize for best presentation was awarded to physiotherapist, **Sarah Osiurak** and the people's choice prize was awarded to physiotherapist, **Renita Manning**.



Allied health was well represented at the Eastern Health Research Forum held in November with poster presentations from physiotherapists Swapna Gokhale, Ali Gibbs, social worker Euan Donley and pharmacist Sam Maleki and oral presentations from Natasha Brusco, Sam Maleki, Amy Dennett and Katherine Harding. The best short oral presentation was awarded to Natasha Brusco for research on "Cost-effectiveness of increasing the dosage of therapy participation during inpatient rehabilitation via self management: My Therapy" and the best long oral presentation was awarded to Amy Dennett for research, "Prehabilitation improves physical capacity before and after autologous stem cell transplant: a randomised controlled trial."

Paper of the year 2023

The 2023 allied health publication of the year has been awarded to health services researcher, Dr Annie Lewis.

Annie's paper aimed to evaluate implementation of the Specific Timely Appointments for Triage (STAT) model of access in an epilepsy clinic to reduce a long waitlist and waiting time. This study used pre-post comparison and an interrupted time series analysis to measure the effect of implementation of the STAT model to an epilepsy clinic over 28 months. The long waitlist was almost eliminated, reducing from 616 during the pre-intervention period to 11 post-intervention (p = 0.002). This reduction in the waitlist did not increase waiting time, and variability waiting time reduced indicating improved equity of access.

Annie's study provides pilot data to suggest that the STAT model of access provides a framework for an alternative way to operate outpatient clinics that can help to ensure that all people referred are offered an appointment in a timely manner.

An independent judge evaluated shortlisted papers on the criteria of quality, impact and clinical relevance. The judge commented on the quality of the short-listed papers singling out Swapna Gokhale's systematic review and meta-analysis for commendation:
