

Guide - How to apply for 2026 Internship

Who can apply?

Intern positions are allocated in Victoria using a priority category system. The Postgraduate Medical Council of Victoria (PMCV) oversees the Allocation and Placement Service (APS) where you will register for the Intern Match. PMCV administers the APS on behalf of the Victorian health services that offer positions and candidates applying for these positions.

Eligibility criteria and order of allocation of Medical Graduates for 2026 intern positions is below:

Victorian Intern Allocation (VIA) & PMCV Eligibility Criteria 2025

Optimised Ballot - Apply to PMCV

Candidates who participate in the Match with the below eligibilities will be subject to the new optimised ballot process. This means applications will only go to the PMCV, you will preference the health service with the PMCV and you will be allocated according to the results of the optimised ballot match to a health service in Victoria.

Group 1	 Graduates from an Australian University identifying as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander. (NEW) Australian Citizen or permanent resident and New Zealand citizens graduating from a Victorian Medical School.
Group 2	 Australian Temporary residents graduating from a Victorian Medical School Australian Citizen or permanent resident and New Zealand citizens graduating from an interstate Medical School but completed year 12 in Victoria.
Group 3	Australian citizen or permanent resident or temporary resident, New Zealand citizens or temporary resident graduating from an Interstate Medical School.

Merit Based Process - Apply to PMCV

Candidates who participate in the Match with the below eligibility will continue to be part of a merit-based process. This means application will only go to the PMCV, you will preference the health service with PMCV and you will be ranked by the health service and considered in the offers in relation to this merit based match process with health services in Victoria participating in this category.

How to Apply

Applications via PMCV

All internship applications must be submitted through the Postgraduate Medical Council of Victoria (PMCV) portal.

Documents Checklist

Make sure you have the following ready before submitting your application:

- Curriculum Vitae (CV) Completed using the PMCV online template (6-page limit)
- Passport-sized Photograph High quality image uploaded with your CV and application

Writing Your CV

Your CV must be completed using the PMCV Online Template and include the following:

- Personal details
- Clinical school attended
- Clinical placements
- Medical degree academic progress
- Achievements, prizes & awards (during medical school)
- · Employment history
- Volunteer work, achievements, research, leadership, and personal interests (community or sporting)

Applying to Eastern Health

Group 1–3: Local Graduates – Preference Only

If you are a local graduate, you must preference Eastern Health in your PMCV application.

Please note: Eastern Health will only complete the ranking step for overseas graduates.

You must submit:

- CV (including academic record)
- Two clinical references (via PMCV)
- Video interview (uploaded to PMCV)

Group 4: Overseas Graduates - Preference & Ranking Required

If you are an overseas graduate, you must preference Eastern Health for your application to be ranked.

You must submit:


- CV (including academic record)
